
ROMANESQUE ROUTE OF ARAN (RRd'Aran)


LET'S DISCOVER!

1 VAL DE TORAN



A tour through small, typical villages near the French border: Porcingles, Bordius, Sant Joan de Toran. At the end of an asphalted road, the Honeria Shelter is the starting point of interesting hiking

2 BAUSEN AND BÒSC DE CARLAC



Hiking route from the village of Bausen, incredible landscapes and a centenary beech forest.

3 LES



Typical village of Baish (Lower) Aran near the French border. It's worth mentioning the SANT BLAS CHAPEL (RR D'ARAN) near the BARONIA DE **LES**, previous residence of the Barons of Les, and at the foot of the FEUDAL CASTLE ruins (XII-XV c.). the CAVIAR NACARII and the TERMAS BARONIA DE LES hot springs.

ADVENTURE PARK -



Adventure park located in the Cauarca campground with zip lines and Tibetan bridge circuits,....with different levels of difficulty.

FIXED CLIMBING ROUTES



2 fixed climbing routes with 3 itineraries with different levels of difficulty. Includes Tibetan bridge located at 200m in altitude.

9 LA CASA DETH SENHOR D'ARRÒS

Manor home from the 19th century location for ceremonies of the Conselh Generau d'Aran, the General Historic Archives and the Institut d'Estudis Aranesi (Aranese Institute of Studies)



11) SAUT DE PISH



Amazing waterfall. Access along the paved forest trail, through the Val de Varradòs forest, with views of the Maladeta massif.

BASSA D'OLES AND BÒSC **DE VARICAUBA**



One of the few small lakes with vehicular access. Ideal to spend the day with the family near the picnic area, Plan Batalhèr.

12 ARTIGA DE LIN AND UELHS DETH JOEU



Access along the paved forest trail that follows the banks of The Joeu to Plan dera Artiga, starting point for hiking routes and the headwaters of the river, in the falls known as "Uelhs deth Joeu". The waters come from the Aneto glacier, running 4km underground, and reappear in this magical spot.

(17) VAL DETH SALIENT




A forest road reaches the tops of the mountain at 2000m: alpine fields, grand panoramic views, easy access to mountain peaks such as Tuc d'Arenho or Pincèla; the Salient Lookout with views over Vielha, are some of the features of this route. SANT ANDRÈU CHURCH : Casau (RR d'Aran)



19 VIELHA



an interesting old town, crossed by the Garona and Nere Rivers.

MUSÈU DERA VAL D'ARAN The history of the valley, from the creation of the Pyrenees to today.

FABRICA DERA LAN The transformation of virgin wool, in a factory from the 19th century converted into a museum.

ÇÒ DE RODÈS Remodeled manor home with a Renaissance façade.

SANT MIQUÈU CHURCH (RR D'ARAN) Important Gothic altarpiece and spectacular image of the Romanesque Christ of Mijaran (12th century).

MENHIR MIJARAN

MOLIÈRES AND BÒSC DE CONANGLES



Trail towards the Molières valley, crowned by the peak with the same name. The trail passes waterfalls and a beech tree forest. The Conangles Shelter is the starting point for an excursion through the forest from which its name comes.

ÇÒ DE PÈIRJOAN Řenaissance manor home.



Ski resort with summer access options from Plan de Beret.

24) ARTIES



Enchanting village of the Val d'Aran with the spectacular Montarto peak (2833m) in the background.

SANTA MARIA CHURCH (RR D'ARAN) Its rich collection of Renaissance mural paintings (16th century) stands out. Declared a Cultural Item of National Interest. **SANT JOAN CHURCH**

Gothic church remodeled as a temporary exposition space of Musèus dera Val d'Aran. CASA PAULET

Home from the 16th century. ÇÒ DE PORTOLÀ Ancient home of the Portolà family, converted

into a National Parador. Tower from the 16th century and chapel from the 17th century. FIXED CLIMBING ROUTE (VIA FERRATA)

RESTANCA AND ESTANH DE MAR



which gives way to the trail reaching the Restanca Shelter. Starting point of spectacular excursions such as Estanh de Mar, Estanh de Rius or Montarto.

26 GESSA



ÇÒ DE ROSA. Manor home with a turret in angle and Renaissance windows.

27 SALARDÚ



Capital of the Naut Aran municipality SANT ANDRÈU CHURCH (RR D'ARAN) A transition church from the Romanesque to the Gothic periods, holds the carving of the Christ of Salardú (12th century) and an important collection of Renaissance mural paintings (16th century). MÒLA DE SALARDÚ

Ancient flour mill in perfect state of

PYRENMUSÈU MUSEUM The experiences of the first explorers and pioneers of the Pyrenees, relived.

23 ESTANHS DE COLOMÈRS



An obligatory hiking excursion in Val d'Aran. on the edges of the National Park of Aigüestortes i Estany de Sant Maurici. A cirgue of glacial origin surrounded by peaks reaching nearly 3000m, overseeing about 50 lakes

BANHS DE TREDÒS The highest hot spring spa in Europe, located at 1740 m.

29 UNHA



SANTA EULÀRIA CHURCH (RR D'ARAN) ÇÒ DE BRASTET Built in 1580, with turrets in angle, arrowholes and other defensive elements. FIXED CLIMBING POI D'UNHA In Poi d'Unha, 3 itineraries, from beginners to experts. 800 m in length and with 500


m of vertical climbing. MUSÈU DERA NHÈU Museum dedicated to ski and snow sports. 30 BAGERGUE

Access from Bagergue on the paved forest trail (only 4x4 vehicles) which gives way to the trail leading to the beautiful landscapes of the Unhòla river and the Urets pass.




33) CIRC DE VACIVÈR



From Plan de Beret, magnificent hiking excursion to the Vacivèr and Rosari Lakes, dominated by Tuc de Vacivèr (Peak).

34) PLAN DE BERET



Fields for grazing and location of the headwaters of the Garona and Noguera Pallaresa rivers. Remains of archaeological monuments. necropolis, monolith (pèires).



Ancient sanctuary surrounded by a spectacularly beautiful landscape, between fields and forests along the Noguera Pallaresa river. Un-paved forest trail.

(37) ESTANHS DE SABOREDO



In Val de Ruda, of glacial origin, there are numerous lakes surrounded by high peaks, located between the limits of our region and that of Pallars Sobirà.

37 PÒRT DE VIELHA



Ancient natural pass used as the communication route between Val d'Aran and Alta Ribagorça, GR-211-5 (16.5km), reaches a height of 2.423m.
